Labor Data

One of the major sources of labor data is the U.S. Department of Labor (http://www.dol.gov/).

DOL History: the DOL was first organized as the Bureau of Labor in January 1885 under act of Congress, approved June 27, 1884 as part of the Department of the Interior. By act of Congress approved June 13, 1888, it became an independent agency with the title of Department of Labor, but without executive rank. It returned to bureau status and was transferred to the newly created Department of Commerce and Labor by act of Congress, approved February 14, 1903. The Department of Labor (DOL), ninth executive department, was created by act approved March 4, 1913, which divided the Department of Commerce and Labor into two separate departments.¹
